How Long would It Take YOU to Be a Graduate of Christian Theology in NOUN?

- The BA Christian Theology programme) takes you only eight (8) semesters for the fulltime mode and sixteen (16) semesters for the ODeL flexible mode.
- To obtain a BA degree in Christian Theology programme, you must pass all the core and required courses, obtain a minimum CGPA of 1.00 and TCE of 120 credit units.
- For direct entry candidate, the graduation requirements include TCE credit units of not less than 90 with a minimum of 6 academic semesters.

How Do YOU Start?

A minimum qualification of five (5) credits at not more than two sittings in GCE, SSCE, NECO, NABTEB, or its equivalent, including English Language and Mathematics; Teachers' Grade II Certification with a minimum of five merits at not more than two sittings including English Language and Mathematics.

For direct entry, a minimum of 3 credit passes in IJMB, OND, NCE or its equivalent in addition to three (3) credit passes at the GCE Ordinary Level, including English Language and Mathematics or a Diploma in Christian Theology or Christian Religious Studies from NOUN and/or any other recognized institution or any other qualification acceptable to the Senate of NOUN.
